The Slovenian Institute for Adult Education (SIAE):

- Founded in 1992 as the umbrella institution for AE
- Three major fields of SIAE's work:
 - Research and development of AE
 - Education of adult educators and counselling
 - **Promotion (1996 →)** and IC infrastructure



LLW briefly



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- **The Slovenian Lifelong Learning Week (LLW) is a country-wide celebration of learning and a member of the international learning festivals' movement.**
- **The Slovenian Institute for Adult Education (SIAE) is the national coordinator of LLW; the overall LLW network consists of above 800 partners - providers of events, about 30 of them act as local/thematic coordinators.**
- **Annually, around 4-5,000 educational, promotional, information and counselling as well as social and cultural events are carried out.**



LLW's role



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LLW mission:

- To promote the importance and role of as well as possibilities for learning and education in all stages of life and for all roles one takes – as an individual or member of a family, workplace and society as a whole.

LLW vision:

- To remain and to grow as the leading promotional campaign in Slovenia, paving the way to a profound understanding and beneficial implementation of the culture of lifelong learning.

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Related to theory:

- To rethink the state-of-art and state-of-theory in the field of lifelong learning
- To capture and present key professional issues and developments in education and learning
- To establish grounds for exchanging opinions between theoreticians and practitioners
- To strengthen research in the field of lifelong learning



Goals and aims of LLW



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Related to policy:

- To advocate and lobby for the implementation of the strategy of lifelong learning
- To call attention to current policy issues and developments in the field of education and learning
- To create links among and foster mutual understanding of learners, professionals, practitioners and decision makers



The Slovenian LLW prides itself on:



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
- Coverage of 'life-long' and 'life-wide' learning


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Type of LLW events



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



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In the period 1997-2010: 174 award winners

- 1) Awards for outstanding achievements in learning and enrichment of one's own knowledge**
(**50** to individuals and **37** to groups)

- 2) Awards for professional or promotional achievements in enriching the knowledge of others**
(**87** to individuals, groups, institutions, firms or enterprises, local communities, media)



Role models attract



- Since 1999: **video-portraits** of award winners, presented at the solemn LLW opening, at LLW venues and on local TVs
- Since 2003 – **‘Role Models Attract’** campaign (compilations of video-portraits on selected topics):
 - 1-3: Equal opportunities for all
 - 4-6: Early, middle and mature period of career
 - 7 and 7a: Richness in diversity
 - 8: Learning – the door to the world of new opportunities
 - 9: Learning and creativity in the third age (coming soon)
- **Printed leaflets** – presentations of 7 SIAE award winners



International projects

2000-2003: Transfer of LLW know-how from Slovenia to South-Eastern Europe; partners:

Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Macedonia, Serbia and Montenegro, Slovenia, Romania. **Follow-up:** two regional learning festivals (Macedonia, 2003 and B&H, 2005);

2002-2004: Widening and Strengthening the European Dimension of the Lifelong Learning Week Movement (LLW-Grundtvig 1); partners: Bulgaria, Germany, Spain, Slovenia, Romania;

2003-2006: IntALWinE (Grundtvig 4) – network of national coordinators from 15 European countries and a network (forum) of adult learners.

2010-2012: Sowing the Learning Seeds; Grundtvig Learning Partnership of 7 participating countries.
