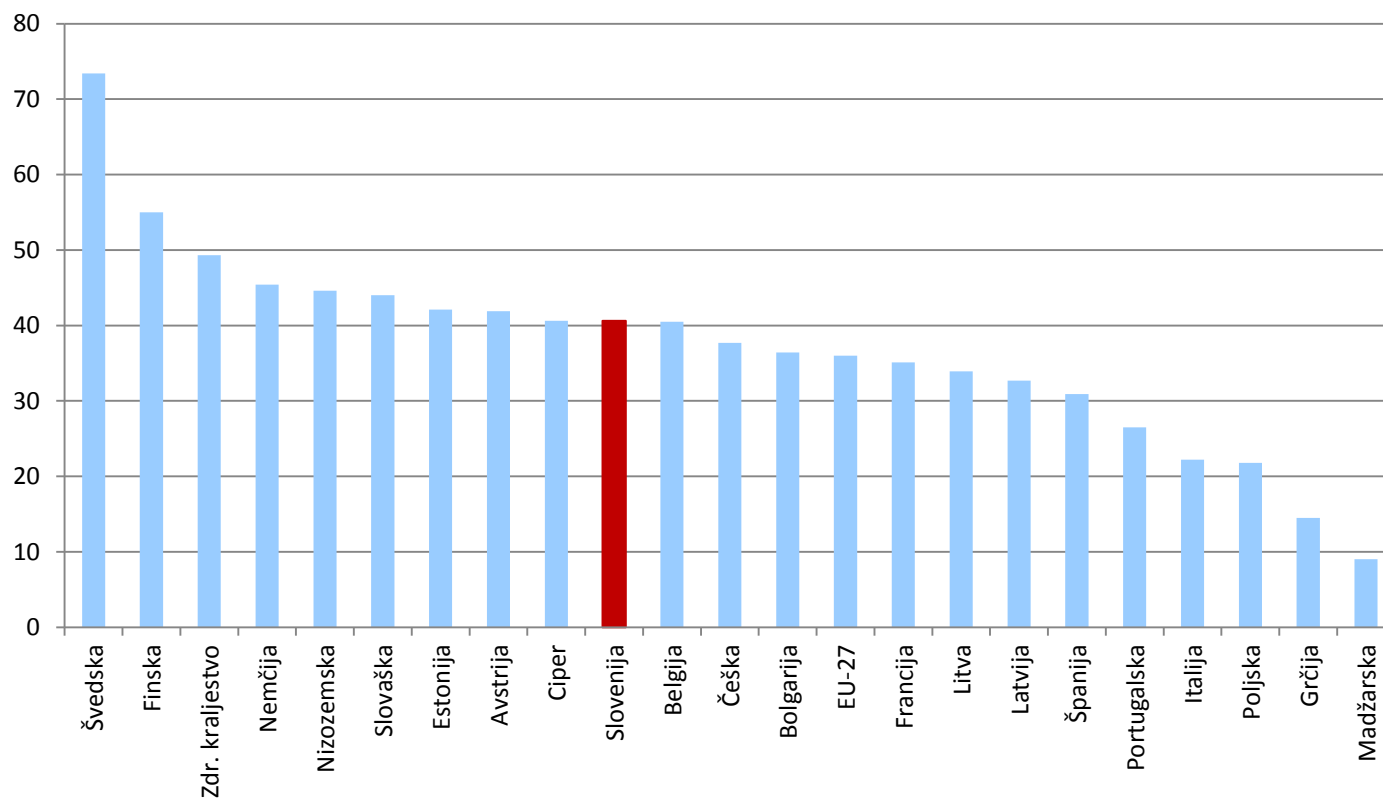


Some facts on Slovenia

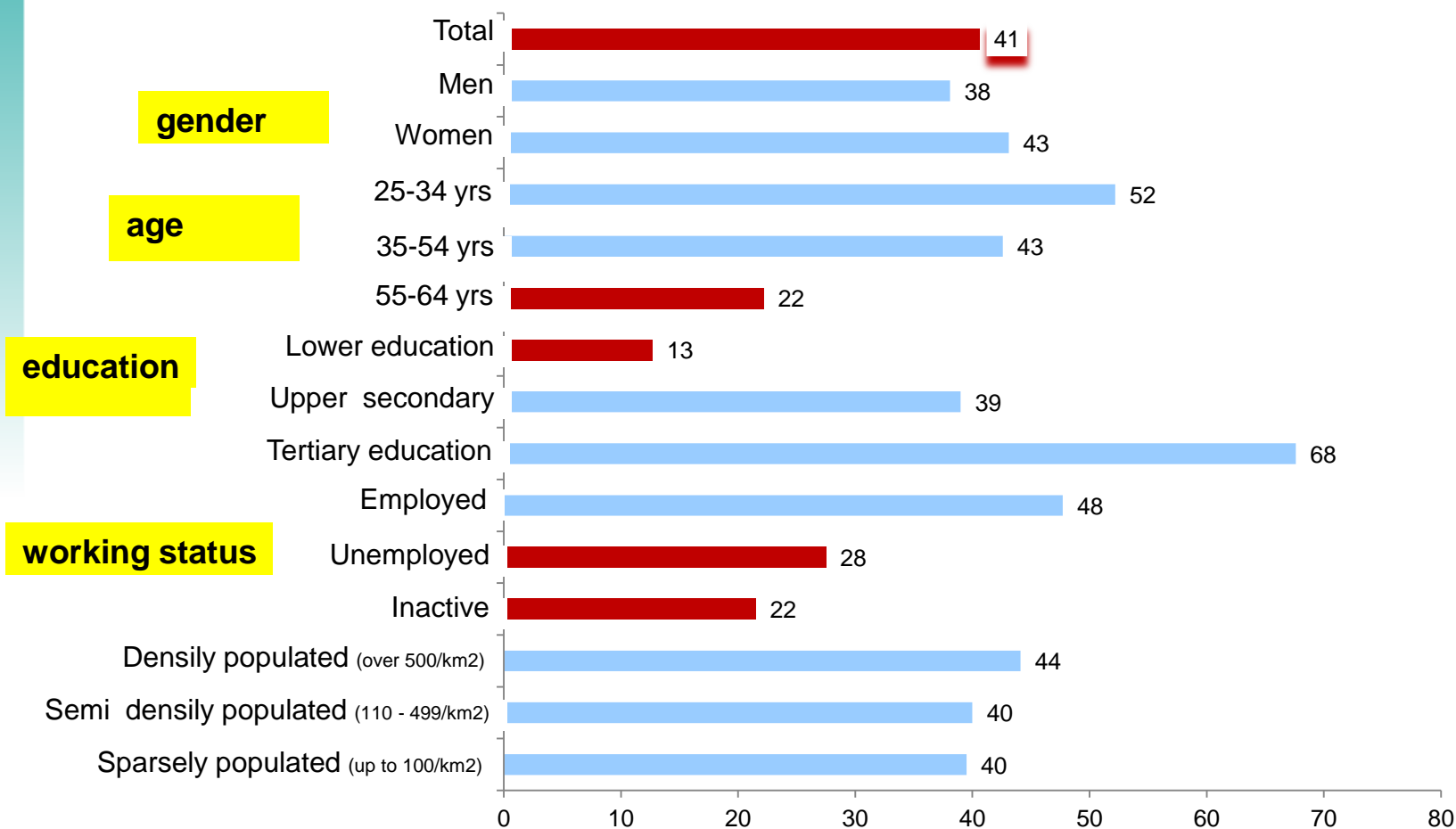
- Surface area: **20,273 km²**
 - Population (2010): **2,046,976**;
 - Aging population: more than **90 %** older than 15 years.
 - Average age **41.4 years**
 - Around **75 %** of adults achieved secondary education or more.

Structural aspects of participation (AES, 2007)



System of governance

- **Adult Education Act** defining status
 - **Adult Education Master Plan** defining priorities
 - formal education of adults,
 - general, non-formal and
 - work-related adult education)
 - **Annual Programme** defining goals, activities and funds

- older adults (65+)
- less educated unemployed people, especially older ones
- deprived people (**people with special needs**, migrants, early leavers from E&T, ethnical groups...)
